

FIBA Canning Inc. announces large Super Jumbo CNG Trailer Order

FIBA Canning Inc. has won a competitive tender process for the production of a large number of super-sized CNG tube trailers for use in Canada. The award was based in part on their superior price, and their long standing reputation for building the largest tube trailers in the world. The trailers are the largest quad axle trailers in Canada and are each capable of hauling close to 300,000 SCF of CNG. The trailers contain fourteen jumbo tubes each and have a water volume of roughly 1285 cubic feet (36,420 litres). The fully loaded units will gross out at roughly 122,375 pounds each.

The UN tubes are manufactured in accordance with ISO standard 11120 and approved by both the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) and Transport Canada (TC). DOT UN tubes have a 10-year requalification cycle in CNG service.

FIBA Canning Inc. is proud to continue their tradition of engineering and design excellence and in supplying their customers the highest quality tube trailers in North America. Their quad axle design will be road legal from Ontario and Quebec through Maritime Provinces, and meet all National Safety Mark and Ontario Safe, Productive, and Infra-Structure Friendly (SPIF) requirements.

The first trailers are scheduled for delivery March 1, 2013.
